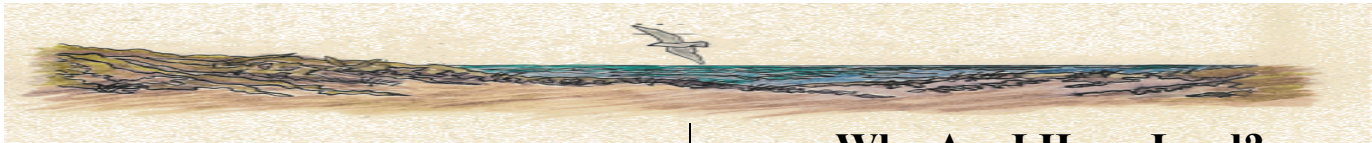

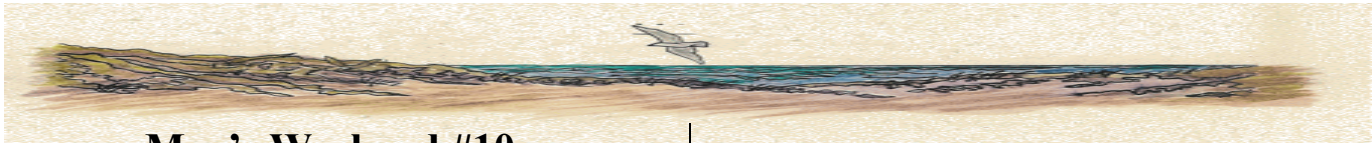

(Zion Lutheran Church is located at 123 Carson Road, Ferguson, MO. From the West: take Hwy 270 North to I-70 East. Exit 240 AB Florissant Road. Turn left on Florissant Road and travel approximately 1.7 miles. Look for the railroad track above Florissant Road and turn left on Carson Road right before the railroad track. Go one long block; turn right on Clark Street to Zion’s parking lot. From Illinois: take I-270 West. Exit 27 South. Turn left on Florissant Road and travel approximately 2 miles. Look for the railroad track make a right turn immediately under the track on Carson Road. Go one long block; turn right on Clark Street to Zion’s parking lot.)

Directions for Non Handicapped Folks:

I-270 to I-44 West. Exit #264 (Highway 109/Eureka Exit). As you exit get in the SECOND line from the right (5th Street). Turn RIGHT (you will be in the 5th Street LEFT TURN lane). After turning LEFT on 5th Street, go 5/10 miles. At the second stop light, turn RIGHT on Meramac (a divided street). Continue until you see ST. MARK'S LUTHERAN on your LEFT. PARK on the far left side of St. Mark's parking lot. See Via de Cristo SIGN. Follow sidewalk down the hill to Hilltop Manor Apartment Complex. Enter through back door.

Directions for Limited Mobility Folks:

I-270 to I-44 West. Exit #264 (Highway 109/Eureka Exit). As you exit get in the SECOND line from the right (5th Street). Turn RIGHT (you will be in the 5th Street LEFT TURN lane). After turning LEFT on 5th Street, go 7/10 miles (going through 2 stop lights).

Turn RIGHT into the McDonald's Parking lot. Drive straight ahead through Center Drive and pull into the lot of Hilltop Manor Apartments. Keep to the RIGHT of the building and go around back. Park in the "employee parking" area. Enter through the back door.
